# Rural Watch and Horse Watch Alerts Bulletin – 14 January 2016

Please be aware of the following incidents, which have occurred at farms and rural premises, across Warwickshire over recent days:

### Incident 66 of 7 January – Dunchurch

During the night of 6 into 7 January, offenders broke into an outbuilding at a farm premises in Dunchurch and stole a Yamaha dark green quad bike and a very large and heavy Karcher steam cleaner.

### Incident 86 of 11 January – Lawford

During the night of 10 into 11 January, offenders entered sheds at a farm premises in Lawford Lane, Rugby and stole a quad bike, a generator and a pressure washer. These items were later found about 200 yards away in a field.

### **Incident 66 of 9 January – Hockley Heath**

Between 8 and 9 January, offenders entered an old outbuilding at a farm premises in Hockley Heath after cropping off the locks. Once inside, the offenders stole an old lawnmower.

### Incident 381 of 11 January - Little Wolford

Between 12noon and 9.40pm on 11 January, offenders stole 3 large copper hot water cylinders from a secluded part of the driveway to a farm premises in Little Wolford.

### Incident 90 of 12 January - Radway

At some point before 10.20am on 12 January, offenders caused damage to fencing and plants at a rented field of a stud premises in Radway.

# Incident 39 of 12 January - Claverdon

During the night of 11 into 12 January, offenders stole an Ifor Williams horse trailer from a rural premises in Claverdon after cutting off the gate lock and wheel and hinge locks.

# Incident 174 of 13 January - Bodymoor Heath

At just after 2pm of 13 January, offenders stole a blue Toyota Hi lux vehicle from from a farm premises in Bodymoor Heath. The offenders had to travel down a long driveway to reach the vehicle and may have been in tandem with a silver Vauxhall Corsa.

# Incident 144 of 12 January – Little Wolford

During the night of 11 into 12 January, offenders stole a large quantity of metal items from a building under renovation at the rear of a farm premises in Little Wolford.

#### Incident 36 of 14 January - Halford

Between 10 and 14 January, offenders entered a secure but derelict cottage at a farm premises in Halford, Shipston on Stour after kicking in the front door and then stole a petrol jet washer.
